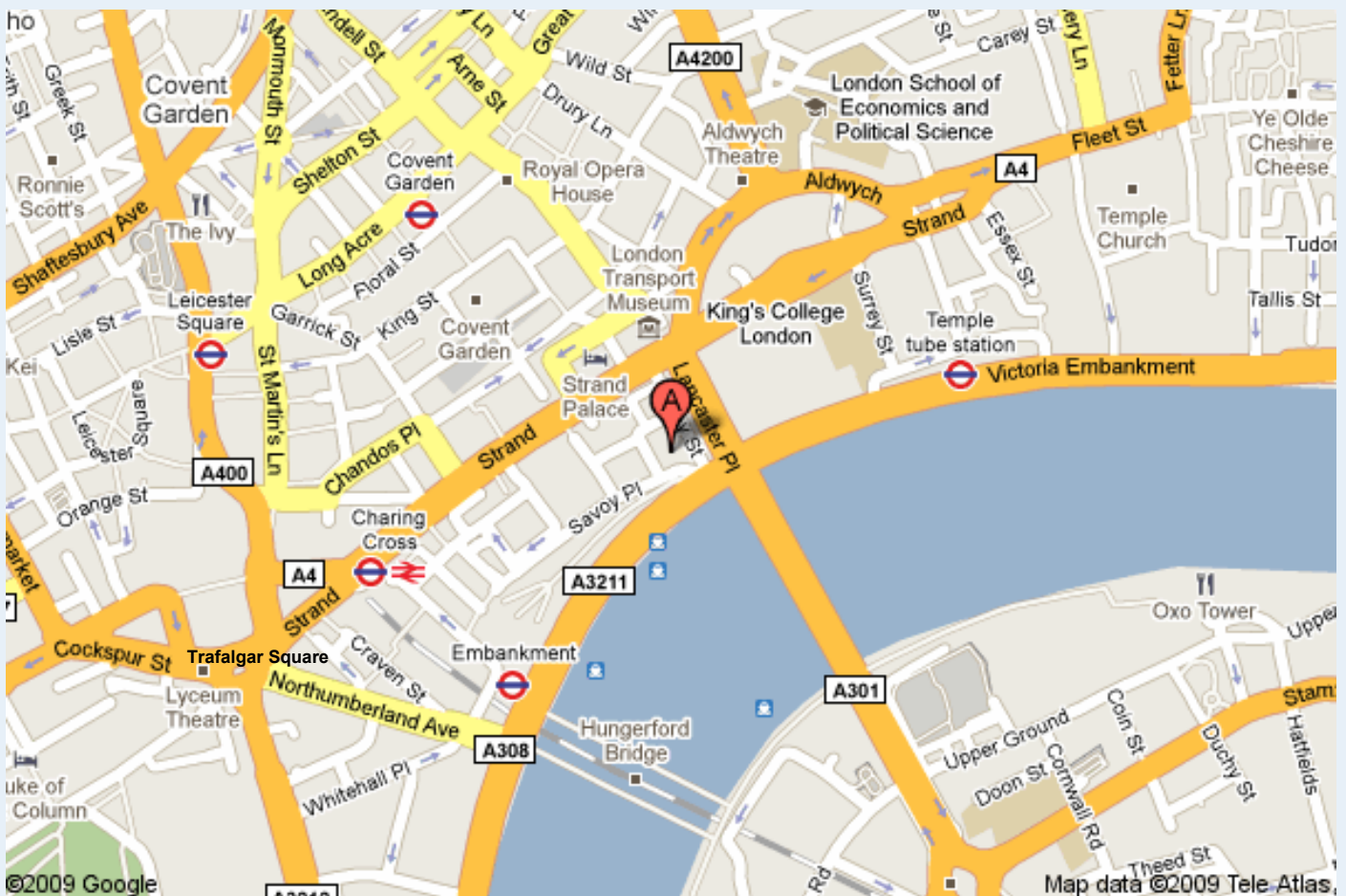

Directions to IET

The nearest tube station is Embankment.

From Gatwick/Victoria

Take the Gatwick Express train to London Victoria Station.

Use the tube to get to Embankment station (District and Circle line)

From Heathrow

Take the tube from Heathrow and change at South Kensington. Change on to the District and Circle line). Get off at Embankment station.

From Stansted

Take a train from Stansted Airport to Liverpool Street Station. Take the Circle Line to Embankment station.

From Luton Airport

Get the connecting bus from the Airport to the railway station called Luton Airport Parkway. Take a train to London King's Cross.

From London City Airport

Get the DLR (Docklands Light Railway) towards Bank. Alight at Bank and follow signs to Monument underground station. Take the District and Circle line to Embankment station.

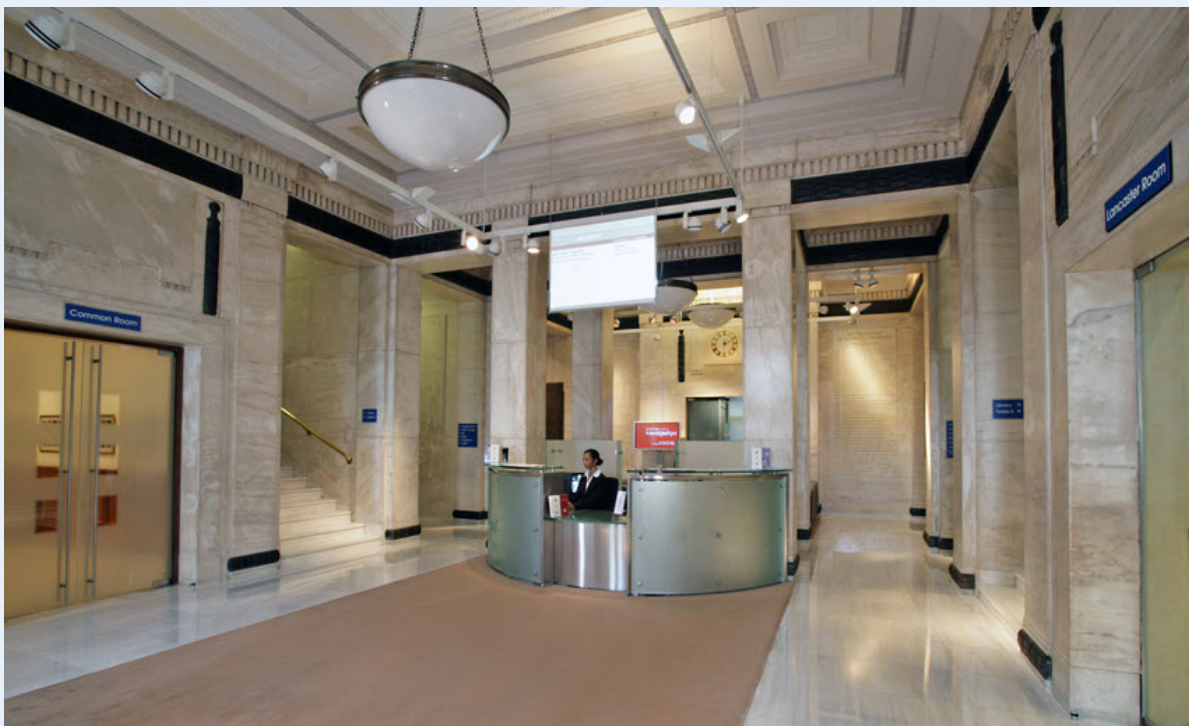
From King's Cross/St Pancras

Get the tube using the Northern Line to Embankment station.

Walking directions from Embankment station

When leaving Embankment station, take the exit marked Embankment Pier/South Bank.

Turn left out of the exit and walk along the Embankment (River Thames on your right hand side) for 5 minutes. Just before the next bridge crossing the Thames, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and turn sharp left into Savoy Place. There is a statue of Michael Faraday on this corner. This is the IET building.
